Tarheel Patriots March on Washington

The crowd listened intently and were very vocal in their approval of a long list of Constitutionalist speakers including one Senator, Jim DeMint of

and extremely well informed on most important issues. We were united in a common cause —the saving of our American way of Life.

I have never been so proud of my country as witnessing this demonstration of a genuine outpouring of outrage at the Socialist policies of this President.

We the People must rise to the occasion and save our Republic from this usurpation of Constitutional power.

we are Mad as Hell and we won't take it any longer.

President Obama and his Administration have set a course towards Socialism and the bankrupting of our economy and his obedient fellow Democrats and some Republicans have blindly fallen in line and approved this social and fiscal insanity. This spontaneous outpouring of outrage by the average citizens of this country at this usurpation of Constitutional powers have renewed our faith in the American people and given us hope that we can halt this gallop into Socialism.

We were part of the Asheville Tea Party group that recently demonstrated at Congressman Heath Shuler's office opposing the President's National Health Care Power Grab. Over two hundred Asheville (and surrounding area) citizens traveled to Washington DC on two chartered buses to participate in this March on Washington. We arrived at the Freedom Plaza shortly after 8 a.m. on Saturday and were greeted by many thousands of other citizens from as far away as Alaska and Hawaii. One American working in Australia made the long journey home to participate in this Protest Rally. We mingled and talked with other demonstrators until shortly after 10 a.m. when local officials gave orders to begin the march one hour early to alleviate crowd congestion in the streets and sidewalks in the Freedom Plaza area.

The North Carolina contingent was fourth in line (a place of honor) because of our activity at Tea Parties leading up to the DC March. As a transplanted Texas Aggie, I was pleased to see the Texas contingent with the largest number of protesters at the Rally, so they led off the March. All of the million plus American Patriots proudly marched down Pennsylvania Ave to the US Capital grounds. It took over one hour for everyone to get as close to the speakers platform as they were going to get. Because North Carolina demonstrators were in the vanguard of the Parade, we got into the Capital grounds whereas people further back in the Parade could only get within one-half mile of the Capital. News photos showed demonstrators stretched half way down the Mall towards the Washington Monument. When queried, several Capital policemen reported to me

South Carolina, several Congressmen including Mike Pence of Indiana and Marsha Blackburn of Minnesota, several other leaders of Patriotic organizations such as Freedom Watch and the 9/12 Project and several ordinary citizens including a West Virginia Coal miner and an elderly gentleman who immigrated from Poland after surviving the Nazi slaughter of Warsaw Polish citizens preceding World War II. Their message was clear and unequivocal — We the People must rise to the occasion and save our Republic from this usurpation of Constitutional power. Most notable at this rally was the absence of political organizers. This was the grassroots of the Nation spontaneously venting their outrage at bloated and out of control federal government.

The protesters carried American Flags (some inverted signifying distress) and Don't Tread on Me flags and many homemade signs protesting everything from National Health Care to the abandonment of the Constitution (It's the Constitution Stupid) and many calling for replacement of the members of Congress.

We met demonstrators from many states but uniformly they were friendly, polite and well mannered

The media has downplayed the attendance at this March describing it as in the tens of thousands but we know that everyone in positions of power in Washington have heard the voice of the people and they are quaking in their boots.

The most important lesson in this for the American people is you cannot trust governmental officials and we must replace the "professional politicians" with average citizens as the fathers of our great nation intended when they founded our Republic. We have allowed the creation of an American aristocracy where the ruling class (President and the Congress) have gotten so out of touch with the common man that they have forgotten that the people selected them and can remove them at will.

This March on Washington has proven that the American people have finally awakened from their long malaise and they will restore Constitutional government.

I predict that this is only the beginning of a citizen revolt against government policies which will ultimately result in the wholesale replacement of most of the "professional politicians" in the Congress in 2010.

Reflections on the 9/12 Tea Party

Place: Washington, D.C.
Freedom Park to The Capital. I walk.

It's 5 p.m. and I'm sitting in the bar at the Willard Hotel, parched and starving. I came here for the "9/12 Tea Party". I heard about it a year ago. I decided then that I was coming. I came with no expectations – what a day!

The police figure there were 1.5 to 2 million plus people. They just kept coming. All everyday people, like me, who got on a bus or drove from all parts of the country to be heard.

One and a half plus million people on the Capitol Lawn, also backed on Pennsylvania Ave. to the Mall, toward the Washington Monument. I was struck silent by it all. The city of D.C. was not ready for our numbers. The P.A. system was only heard on the Capitol grounds. Porta Potties use had an hour and a half wait, but a lovely time was had by all. Friendly people, a relaxed (but very serious) beautiful Fall day. I'm so glad that I came. I saw history made today!

I know now that our Republic might survive, for every one of us there, there are many, many more who were unable to come.

The President has called us "out". Well, we're "out"! We have a lot to say, and we're not going away.

Millions of protesters jam D.C. to protest Obama regime

WASHINGTON, DC – September 12 – “Overwhelmed,” “jazzed,” “like having an out of body experience,” and “unable to find words” are expressions some people from Western North Carolina used to describe the buzz from the 9/12 March on Washington DC. Lies, czars, bailouts, and government healthcare were the prime movers hauling patriots from all over America to a history-making protest

sources estimate there were 650,000. Danny Lack said he and Ryan Croft were perched on a hill close to the security fence on the stage in front of the Capitol. He could see that the Mall and Pennsylvania Avenue, and another street off to the left. “As far as I could see, and I have decent eyes, there was nothing but people.”

in the nation's capital. The event was instigated to talk host Glenn Beck's response to a hopeless plea to "Do something!" about America's increasing dependence on godless government.

How Many?

Friday before the event, at 7 a.m., 120 people boarded two buses in the parking lot of Biltmore Square Mall to head for Washington, DC. Several personal vehicles followed. The Buncombe County 9-12 Project booked the buses, and local Tea Party mover and shaker Erika Franzi made arrangements for hotel accommodations. Participants were very insistent that it be known that they paid their own way, and they were not professional protesters. The 9-10 hour bus trip was described as grueling, with insufficient legroom and not the best of treatments for bad backs. Yet, those who murmured said they would go through it again in a heartbeat.

The local contingency was joined by conservatives from all over the country who are fed-up with government irresponsibility. Reports of the total turnout vary. European sources say the number was over 2 million, but American news

mile stretch on Pennsylvania Avenue would hold 680,000 people shoulder to shoulder, and the mile stretch where he was stationed turned over five times. Though photos don't show shoulder-to-shoulder people, several participants related that the roads were shut down due to the crowd, and traffic was backed up as far as Fredericksburg, VA. Commuters can argue that the Beltway is the nation's largest parking lot, but backups this extensive on a Saturday would be atypical. Regardless, many are calling the event the largest gathering of conservative protesters ever. In addition, conservatives rallied that day at local protests staged in their own states.

Gary Shoemaker was quick to point out that 1 in 300 Americans managed to haul themselves to Washington, DC for the protest. Bill Lack noted that persons came from every state in the union, and Kenneth Hawkins met an American who was working in Australia, but flew home to participate in the march. On the flipside, Bruce Thorne from Pisgah Forest observed, "There wasn't a political bureaucrat in town. All the so called leaders of America were AWOL."

Several protesters remarked they

ACORN rally with 40 people. The Washington, DC webcams managed to malfunction for the duration of the protest, and the president himself jetted off to Minnesota. Franzi said she waved to the plane as it flew overhead.

The Issues

In general, patriotic Americans are shocked to see America become what some have called "enemy occupied territory" in so short a time. Since taking office, President Obama has worked hard to nationalize the banks, the auto industry, energy companies, and healthcare. Americans have studied enough history and economics to appreciate the self-correcting path to prosperity afforded by a free market. They understand that government, which runs without a profit motive and keeps its customers coming back, not with quality goods and services but through its legislative and taxing powers, lacks the private-sector's incentives to provide quality goods and services.

Marchers called for personal empowerment. They were disgusted to see America become a society of parasites where just about everybody

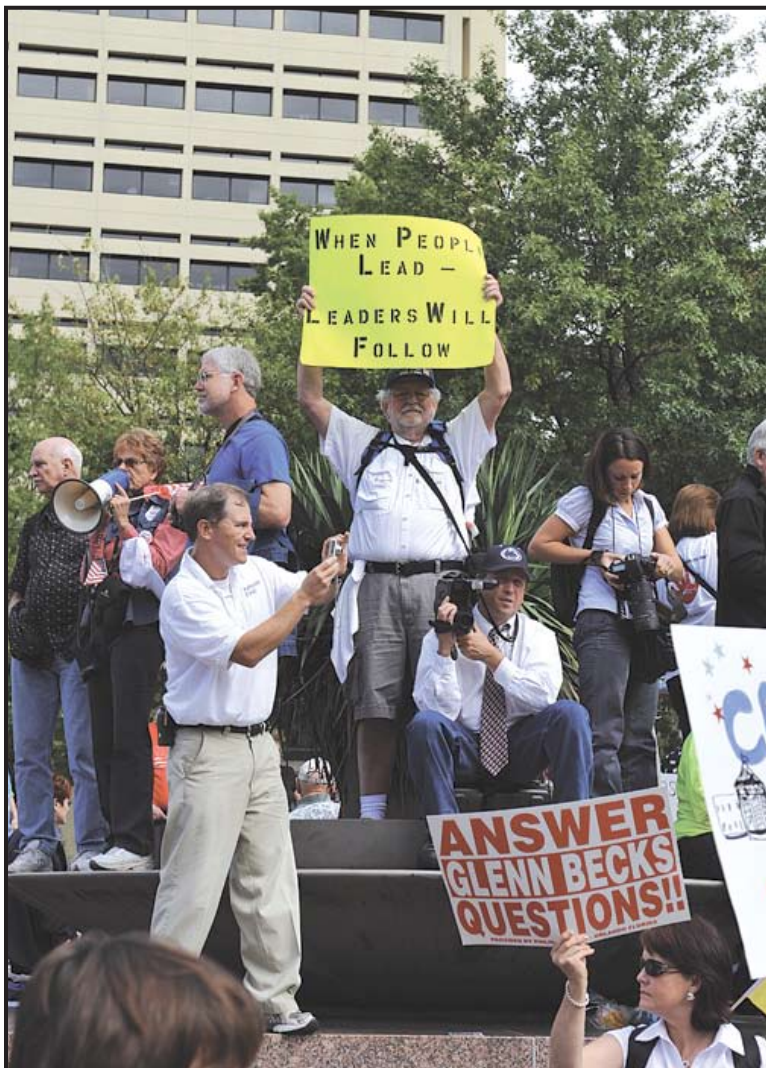

the regulatory "nightmare" of the European Union in international

healthcare.

Asked how he came to understand the Constitution so well, Maltry said he reads about a book a week.

Asked for recommended titles, he suggested *The 5000 Year Leap* by W. Cleon Skousen, *Common Sense* by Glenn Beck, and books

by Ron Paul. Maltry said he didn't campaign for Paul, but found him to be a very intelligent writer. He didn't vote for Obama, either, but

be reinstated as the only 'contract with America.' Term limits and recalls will hold candidates true to their pledges."

A delegation of 25 from Jackson County all agreed they were, "fed up with government spending, excessive control over individual rights, unprecedented power grabs by the administration, and the assault from Washington, DC on the US Constitution."

Pamela Dashiell of Pisgah Forest recollected, "Prior to the march, while at a McDonald's restaurant with other attendees from Asheville, a Metropolitan Police officer looked at me and my rally sign of protest and said to me, 'There isn't going to be anyone at your rally, and there will be no media coverage of it.' I looked at him and said 'What are you talking about?!' He told me that he would have been notified ahead of time if there was to be a big crowd, and he had not had such information. He also added that they have protest rallies all of the time in DC and ours was nothing special!"

Hawkins recalled, "Local officials gave orders to begin the march one hour early to alleviate crowd congestion in the streets and sidewalks in the Freedom Plaza area." Protesters were supposed to be organized by state for the march, with priority placement for states with the hottest activism. Since Texas had the largest contingency (estimated by some to be 65,000), it got to go first. North Carolina got to go fourth. The order was lost in the shuffle as people made new friends.

Hawkins described the logistics. "All of the million plus American

patriots proudly marched down Pennsylvania Ave. to the US Capitol Grounds. It took over one hour for everyone to get as close to the speakers' platform as they were going to get. Because North

Carolina demonstrators were in the vanguard of the parade, we got into the Capitol Grounds, whereas people further back in the parade could only get within ½ mile of the Capitol."

Hensley recollected, "God accommodated us with excellent

temperature and blocked the sun with a non-raining cloud cover. Many thanks. Government was not so accommodating. Restrooms were locked in the Met. It got worse; there were no porta-potties available until the end of the march at the Capitol, a mile away."

Hensley described the scene as "a patriotic Woodstock where the garbage was put in the cans and beside the cans when they filled. There were no drugs, but the crowd was high on freedom and liberty. Anyone approached was like an old friend. It was definitely a weekend of 'love and peace.'"

People who were on the streets said 99 percent of the signs were angry, but not racist or hateful. They regret that the little press coverage the event got focused on the most shocking signs in the crowd. Favorites sign slogans recalled by participants included,

"Tea today, tar tomorrow," "It's the Constitution, Stupid," "Don't make us come back here!" and "Austrian business cycle theory." Donald Lear from Asheville observed that the

most quoted person on the signs was Thomas Jefferson. Quotes followed a theme Lear paraphrased as, "The protections of our liberties need to be constantly renewed or government is going to squash them eventually." Several sported a main

theme of the event, references to Joe Wilson's (R-SC) outburst, "You lie!" It was joked that these signs would be recyclable for years to come. Another repeater was, "We're mad as h***, and we're not going to take it any longer."

Just about every sign was homemade, and ranged from last-minute scratches with a Sharpie to polished professional jobs. At least one had a photo of the president with Joker lipstick. One had the famous painting of George Washington with his arm outstretched asking a three-letter, text-message obscenity; and another had Obama in surgeons' clothes, with a syringe and the words, "This is gonna hurt." American flags abounded, as did Gadsden (yellow "Don't tread on me") flags.

Lear walked with his wife, Jody, who has a master's degree in political science and reportedly makes him look like a liberal. Bob Pauly recalled walking alongside an 80-year-old woman with a rolling walker. As the crowd marched past the Newseum building, which has the First Amendment writ large on the side, a spontaneous chant of "Read the wall!" broke out.

Carol Adams' sign read, "This is the first time in my life I am afraid of my government!"

She said her favorite chant was, "Can you hear us now?" and if the answer was no, the protesters would come back with their friends.

Danny Lack marched alongside a man named Pablo. Pablo had come from Virginia, but he said he was really saddened that he had come to the US and gotten his citizenship, only to see this country make the same mistakes Bolivia had made. Lack told him that was one of the reasons so many people had come to the capital. They were trying to prevent what happened in Bolivia from happening here. "Then, Pablo smiled big, looked around, swept his arm around at the crowd, and said, 'That's why I love this country.'"

One of the most astonishing observations was that there were no police incidents. Security commented to many participants about the unprecedented congeniality and good behavior of the group. Several also commented on the lack of trash.

The Speeches

Few recalled the words of the speeches, but many swore up and down the speakers were great.

The Reverend C. L. Bryant from Shreveport, Louisiana was a favorite of many. In an impassioned speech, he declared, "This country was given to us divinely. . . . Government is not God, and we will not bow down to any thirsty king! . . . We don't get our freedoms from Democrats, Republicans, or presidents! We are empowered, and our rights are endowed by our Creator!" He went on to say that politicians

are building walls of hatred and racism and then exclaimed, "Mr. Obama! Tear down this wall!" He spoke strongly against government takeover of American industries and said he wanted intelligence agents to protect the country "by any means possible."

Senator Mike Pence (R-IN) was another favorite. He said, "After nine years of fighting runaway spending here on this hill, you people look like the cavalry to me. . . . While some are prepared to write the obituary on capitalism and the conservative movement, I believe we are on the verge of a great American awakening." Jim DeMint (R-SC) opened his speech illuminating the un-Constitutional aspects of Obamacare with the words, "Welcome to Waterloo."

Most speakers were intentionally relative unknowns to prevent the rally from becoming a cult of personality. They included a West Virginia coal miner, a man who lost his car dealership due to government policies, and an immigrant from Poland who survived the Nazi slaughter. Hawkins recalled, "Their message was clear and unequivocal: We the People must rise to the occasion and save our Republic from this usurpation of Constitutional power. . . . This was the grassroots of the nation spontaneously venting their outrage at bloated and out of control federal government."

Danny Lack recalled a lady taking the stage to tell people they had to get out of the mall because the demonstration permit did not extend to that area. The crowd started booing, and one guy shouted, "It's our mall," and hundreds followed suit. The echoes from the crowd were so loud, they were picked up by the microphones on stage and broadcast through the PA system. They "drowned the lady out," so she let them stay.

Aftermath

Through the controversial group Organizing for America, the president is allowed to solicit support

and contributions for his political causes. One tactic employed by the organization is to ask people to search their emotions deeply for anecdotal stories. The stories, then, are supposed to be proof that government is the end all and cure all. It's a leap, but it's working. 9/12 marchers, contending that the individual is sovereign, "put a face on the pain" caused by Organizing for America and other moving parts of the president's machine.

Clayton Montgomery, 60, of Canton, explained, "It was a gathering of proud Americans who have had enough of the government pushing its power on them. We came and we made ourselves heard, and we'll do it again if need be. If I were a Washington politician I would be very afraid of November 2010."

Bob Pauly felt the revolution was already brewing. "It's getting to be a war of ideas. It's crazy what they're doing to this country. Absolutely crazy!"

Fred Clas of Tryon recalled, "What happened on 9/12 in Washington, DC was much more than a march to protest President Obama's healthcare change agenda. It was much more than the latest wave of protests against runaway government spending that started with the Tea Parties last April 15th. It was a tsunami of frustration and anger pent-up for decades in the hearts and minds of America's silent majority who can no longer stand by and watch their country be changed into a society they do not recognize. . . . When we Americans, hundreds of thousands strong, sang the 'Star Spangled Banner' and 'God Bless America,' waving our flags high and proud, we sealed an oath first stated by Our Founding Fathers to mutually pledge to each other our lives, our fortunes and our sacred Honor. This is not over. Our voices will be heard. We want our country back!"

Dance Teacher Fired for Using Religious Music in Class Goes to Trial

El Cajon, CA – A dance teacher, who was terminated from her job after a complaint was made that

she used religious music in her instruction, is in trial this week. The single complaint which cost the

teacher her job came from a school staff member rather than a parent or student. In addition to secular music on the day in question, the instructor, Kathy Villalobos, used a rendition of Dona Nobis Pachem, Canon in D and O Si Funi Mungu. Dona Nobis Pachem is a baroque piece by J.S. Bach and is sung in Latin. O Si Funi Mungu, which is translated as "Praise God," is sung in Swahili, though the song has some Eexamined the teacher on her views of the Trinity. The jury sat attentive as the songs were played in court last week. Villalobos then testified as to the educational purpose for the selections.

Despite emails and testimony to the contrary, the District is claiming that Villalobos was not fired because of the religious music but for reasons such as pupil attendance class scheduling. Yet, the school is inconsistently claiming that it was justified in firing Villalobos to prevent a violation of the separation of church and state. "It is clearly constitutional and legal for a teacher to use both religious and secular music as a part of instruction," commented Brad Dacus, president of Pacific Justice Institute.
